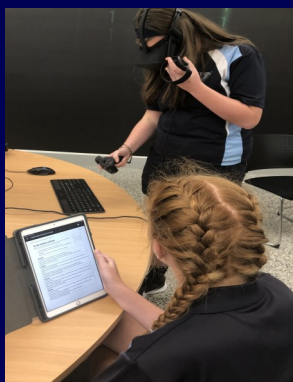


Selection Process
